## NAMING OF EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

## **Background**

Each community shall have the opportunity to participate in the naming of educational facilities within the community.

## **Procedures**

- 1. The name of an educational facility may
  - 1.1. Honour deceased individuals who were prominent at the local, provincial, or national level.
  - 1.2. Be identified with a group.
  - 1.3. Include only the location.
  - 1.4. Identify a geographical or other prominent feature.
- 2. The name selected is not to be in conflict with the names of other schools in the Division.
- 3. The Superintendent shall select a committee for the naming of the school.
- 4. The committee will be chaired by a local trustee and shall have representation from the community at large, the school administration, the local teaching staff, the school council, and the students.
- 5. The Superintendent will serve in an ex-officio capacity.
- 6. The committee will recommend three names to the Board, giving the reasons for each choice.
- 7. The Board shall approve the name of the facility.
