

Administrative Procedure 506

OUT-OF-ATTENDANCE AREA TRANSPORTATION FEES

Background

Transportation fees may be necessary for students wishing to attend schools outside of their attendance area.

Procedures

1. Transportation fees are set to supplement costs incurred for any student transportation provided outside of the *School Act* and Alberta Education policy or regulation.
2. The fees for out-of-attendance area transportation shall be established annually by the Board.
3. Students shall not be transported until the assessed fees for out-of-attendance boundary transportation have been paid. Said fees shall be paid annually. Refunds will be prorated if transportation is terminated.
4. The student transportation fee is applicable to all regular students accessing Division transportation services to attend an out-of-attendance area school.
5. No refunds will be made except in cases where the student no longer rides the bus. The refund will be paid on a pro-rated basis until April 15, after which no refunds will be made.
