OUT-OF-ATTENDANCE AREA TRANPORTATION FEES

Background

Transportation fees may be necessary for students wishing to attend schools outside of their attendance area.

Procedures

- 1. Transportation fees are set to supplement costs incurred for any student transportation provided outside of the *School Act* and Alberta Education policy or regulation.
- 2. The fees for out-of-attendance area transportation shall be established annually by the Board.
- 3. Students shall not be transported until the assessed fees for out-of-attendance boundary transportation have been paid. Said fees shall be paid annually. Refunds will be prorated if transportation is terminated.
- 4. The student transportation fee is applicable to all regular students accessing Division transportation services to attend an out-of-attendance area school.
- 5. No refunds will be made except in cases where the student no longer rides the bus. The refund will be paid on a pro-rated basis until April 15, after which no refunds will be made.
