Funding Framework Review

The Board of Trustees approved a policy for submission to Zone 2/3 of the Alberta School Boards Association (ASBA), calling for the Alberta Government to "undertake a comprehensive review of the K-12 Funding Framework, and the effectiveness and outcomes of the per-student funding formulas."

If approved by Zone 2/3 at their meeting on April 28, the policy will be considered for ratification at the ASBA general meeting in November.

Meeting with the Minister

Aspen View Public Schools, represented by Board of Trustees chair Dennis MacNeil and Trustee Nancy Sand, will share concerns regarding the current Funding Framework for K-12 education, in particular its impact on rural Alberta, in an upcoming meeting with Alberta Education Minster Hon. David Eggen. Aspen View will also speak to the Minister to support of a single publicly-funded school system in Alberta.

Other topics to be discussed at the meeting include the proposed Education Act, the impact of the carbon levy, and curriculum review.

Attendance Area changes

Following lengthy discussion including a review of stakeholder feedback, the Board of Trustees approved an attendance area change that moves an area from the Vilna attendance area into the Smoky Lake attendance area. Currently, 23 students from this area attend school in Smoky Lake; two attend in Vilna.

The attendance area change is effective for the start of the 2017-18 school year. Families affected will be contacted individually by Aspen View Schools. Decisions regarding student transportation options, etc. are forthcoming. Two proposed changes involving the Athabasca and Boyle attendance areas were not approved; those areas will remain the same.

Other highlights:

• Whispering Hills Primary School (WHPS) Grade 2 teacher David Lundell attended the board

meeting with his students to provide details on a 'schoolground greening' initiative, the goal of which is to create a more ecologically

diverse schoolyard around WHPS. The school will be pursuing grants, community partnerships and other fundraising to support the project.

• The Board of Trustees voted to send a letter of Alberta Municipal Affairs Minister Hon. Shaye Anderson, in support of newly proposed changes to the Municipal Government Act that arose from consultation with Alberta school boards.
